

# **TODAY'S SECURITY CHALLENGES**

Many residential and business communities spend their lives living and working in fear of crime and antisocial related disorder. Every year local authorities spend at least £1/2M responding to these types of incident, as police visit the scene once, and on sometimes twice or even more every day.

Some extreme cases have CCTV installed and monitored by the local authority, but with little effect. This is because up until now public open space CCTV security surveillance has been the most technically problematic to deliver, and has placed the greatest strain on local authority resources to support. These CCTV camera Installations need to be controlled and monitored by surveillance operators in order to monitor and point them in the right direction.







## **Example of installation success**

A very general example of the majority of Community Safety Watch installations, the local council would have exhausted several years of crime reduction initiatives working with and on behalf of the community. The worst extreme cases would even have CCTV installed, with expensive communications to the local authorities remote surveillance centre for their operators to proactively monitor. However due to variouse problems faced by local authority's, this had little effect and crime and antisocial behaviour still persist with drug related crime, violent crime including racial attacks being common place.

An Intelligent CCTV camera is installed called a Viseum Intelligent Moving camera or Viseum IMC. This camera is proven to give reassurance for the community that they are being constantly protected, and also a major deterrent to would-be-offenders. As a show of strength, the camera is initially instructed to look out for and follow the majority of all goings-on in the whole area. Results from this initial stage are immediately apparent and evidence from the camera is soon used to rid the community of the known repeat offenders.

Following this period (typically no more than 4 months for the worst cases) the area is downgraded from a high crime environment, to a low crime area only to expect the typical random incidents that any public area may experience. The Viseum IMC camera is then given new instructions to look out for incidents of this nature, and is given details of any local knowledge of incidents to expect at specific times or the day or week.



## **Residential Communities**

A security system keeping privacy issues intact, by generally being a passive CCTV security service but responding to the cameras reports of disorder in the area. Nobody ever watches live or recorded video unless a crime is committed and even then only relevant recordings are automatically retrieved for authorized viewing.



### **Business Communities**

A more proactive CCTV security service where a response is provided once the camera reports certain types of incident that it has been instructed to look out for. For example; potential or confirmed intruders, unauthorised vehicles entering or leaving the site, criminal damage to include graffiti and loitering with intent.
